Tasting Notes

This wine is smooth and full-bodied, with flavors of dark cherry and blackberry with a warm and subtle white pepper finish.

Winemaking Notes

The Mosaico represents the union of Syrah from the Edna Valley with Grenache from the warmer Paso Robles region. This cool climate Syrah always has the benefit of ripening slowly. In addition, the 2015 growing season in California was affected by drought which resulted in low yields and flavorful grapes. This Syrah is full-bodied and brings an elegance with mesmerizing aromatics, smooth and well-structured tannins, and bright acidity to this wine.

In 2015, the warm Paso Robles region was impacted by the ongoing drought. Grenache, usually a vigorous vine, had low yields and therefore greater concentration. This Grenache brings a beautiful red fruit profile to this wine.

After years resting in the bottle, this wine is soft, elegant and a journey that will be remembered!

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
