German for "Gambler," Zocker celebrates our risky venture of growing rare, old world aromatic varieties in the Edna Valley. With its long, cool growing season, marine influence and volcanic soils, the Edna Valley is well-suited for producing high-quality aromatic wines. Made by our Veteran Winemaker Rob Takigawa, the Zocker wines from Baileyana Winery are celebrated for their high acidity, intense aromatic nature and versatility on the dinner table.

2019 Grüner Veltliner

TASTING NOTES

Round and energetic, with great acid structure, this wine is steely and has pronounced minerality. It has bright aromas of lemon and lime on the nose, a strong white pepper note, and flavors of ripe melon and fruit cocktail.

VINTAGE

The 2019 growing season featured a mild summer which allowed the grapes to ripen slowly. Heat waves and rain spells were limited, and the harvest was slow and cool. As a result, this vintage shows exceptional quality and elegance.

"Light, bright yellow. Lemon pith, dried pear and succulent herbs on the incisive nose. Firm and lively in style, showing good depth to citrus and orchard fruit flavors, which reveal a refreshingly bitter edge on the back half. Closes taut and dry, with building quinine and fennel notes and a spicy jolt of candied ginger. I like the uncompromising style of this wine."
